

# **Update from the Pastor's Desk**

God has called us to build champions through a Gospel revolution that brings transformation to our families, community, city, and world.

As I consider all the different things that God is doing in our midst I can't help but be extremely thankful. I will mention some personal things first and then share some exciting things that are happening at Heart and Soul. Nine months ago, our dear Pastor Joanne went to be with the Lord. The same day of that 9 month marker, my son Daniel turned eight years old. I can't help but continue to be amazed at the constant tug in my heart between the pain of losing this woman who meant everything in the world to me and the children, and also the joy of seeing the children growing and blossoming. Sara is now 9 months old, and growing healthy, beautiful, and active! Sara Sofia is the reason these days you might catch me with a silly smile on my face even when I'm not with her. What a joy. She is sleeping through the night for daddy and I know God has had special grace towards me in parenting this wonderful baby daughter. Daniel is eight now, loving school, friends, and good family times. This boy continues to fill my life with joy and thankfulness. He is always asking great questions and reminding me to drive the speed limit.

God is good. God continues to minister to us, strengthen us, love us, and remind us of His faithfulness and unfailing love.

At the same time, life often reminds us that Joanne, this amazing wife, mother, and pastor is not with us anymore. I have continued to shed some great tears, but also smiled as I recalled great memories of our 8 years together. For those of you who followed Joanne's journey with Lyme disease, you know how much she suffered. I am so thankful that she is not suffering any more. She is with the Lord. She is Rejoicing in the presence of the One who makes all things new. It doesn't help me miss her less, but it does remind me of our great hope. Just the other night, Daniel, Sara and I watched the video tribute that was put together for Joanne's services. This was a miracle in itself because it had been too painful to watch in a while. Daniel and I cried much, and we laughed much. We felt the pain, but we smiled at the wonderful memories. Daniel was insistent that Sara watch mommy's video. It was a moment I will never forget.

Just last night I was reading this passage that was another encouraging word from the Lord:

Listen, I tell you a mystery: We will not all sleep, but we will all be changed—in a flash, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, the dead will be raised imperishable, and we will be changed. For the perishable must clothe itself with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality. When the perishable has been clothed with the imperishable, and the mortal with immortality, then the saying that is written will come true: "Death has been swallowed up in victory." "Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?" The sting of death is sin, and the power of sin is the law. But thanks be to God! He gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

We have victory through Jesus Christ. God wins over death. Joanne is in victory because of Jesus. These are comforting words. There was a young family from a sister church that recently lost their husband and dad to a tragic accident. My heart has been moved by their situation. It is not lost on me that tragedies are occurring all around. Some known, and some unknown. Our hope is still the same, "Death has been swallowed up in victory." Thank you for all the prayers, blessings, and support you give to the children and I. I know we have been blessed with world class friends, and world class family members. We love you.

Many reported having had meaningful connections with folks from the community. As we were out and about I personally connected with a gentleman who I had not seen in years. Our conversation ended with prayer and tears flowing from this man's eyes. God is at work! Our Eastside Community Church brothers and sisters joined us for this outreach. It was a blessing to see the body of Christ out in the community sharing and serving.
